Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

This phase 2 request will help to improve multimodal access from the Morris College surrounding area to Downtown Sumter, a major employment, retail, and health center, for the thousands of people living in the underserved neighborhoods surrounding Sumter's central business district. This will make the North Main Street Corridor safer for pedestrians, bikers, and drivers alike. This phase 2 request also has local funding in the amount of \$5,000,000 and federal funding in the amount of \$11,400,000 as a part of the project as a whole which includes a large portion of N Main St and the Manning Ave corridor.

Please provide the scope of services for the project.

North Main Street at Morris college project includes landscaping, irrigation, brick columns, fencing and signage along the North Main Street in front of Morris college. This total project includes a new gateway entrance and entry drive into the Morris College along East College Street. This work also will include streetscape and security enhancements with space for a future relocated/ new gate house and fencing. Work will coordinate with a proposed medical facility building located on the corner of Brown Street and College Street. Phase 1 of this project focused primarily on the right of way areas along N. Main St that compliments a major corridor improvement along N Main St, and this phase 2 continues from N Main St into Brown St and College St to continue the streetscaping done along N Main St, as well as add the security enhancements as you enter into Morris College.

Please provide a timeline / schedule for completion of the project.

The project concept designs have been approved by the parties involved. We are currently awaiting survey to be complete to begin the design process. Once survey is received the construction documents will take about 2 months with permitting about 1 month. Approximately 6 months to complete this phase.


