Dear Ms. Lawton:

The South Carolina Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration approved an Environmental Assessment (September 2012), a Finding of No Significant Impact (February 2013), and a re-evaluation (November 2013) for the above referenced project. Since the November 2013 re-evaluation, the design has been modified to reduce relocation and property impacts. The EA identified two relocations and those properties will not be relocated. Relocations of tracts 21 and 36 are no longer needed. Additionally, the parcel at Whispering Hollow (tract 44) was originally identified as a partial take but is now a full take due to access. There is no relocation associated with tract 44 as this land is now vacant. Therefore, this re-evaluation is necessary and is being submitted for your review and concurrence.

Overall, the project's environmental impacts are expected to be minor, and the basic conclusions of the previous environmental documents, including the EA/FONSI, have not changed. Additionally, special commitments and mitigation measures will be implemented as outlined in the EA/FONSI. Therefore, we request your concurrence with this re-evaluation.
