Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

2022 SCDOT traffic data shows that approximately 51,200 vehicles travel along this 2-lane roadway on a daily basis which far exceeds the capacity of the roadway, leading to congestion, delays, and numerous accidents. Proposed improvements would provide additional capacity to reduce congestion and associated accidents as well as providing bicycle and pedestrian accomodations along the corridor where none currently exist. This project also seeks to replace the bridge over Church Creek (and the CSX railroad) and provide improved drainage along the corridor to alleviate flooding issues. As this improvement project is located along the Ashley River Road National Scenic Byway, great care will be taken to ensure impacts to historical and scenic sites will be avoided and impacts to grand live oak trees will be limited to preserve th enature of the scenic route adjacent to the Ashley River.
