Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

The project is a critical street improvement project focusing on enhancing a half-mile stretch of N. Poinsett Highway from Center Street to the intersection with Hawkins Road. This stretch of road serves as a major thoroughfare for the City of Travelers Rest, but experiences regular traffic accidents. Regrettably, there have been nearly 300 collisions on this stretch of road over the past decade, including at least one fatality. The project is essential for enhancing transportation safety on a major throughfare in the City of Travelers Rest and once complete will foster a safe, efficient street infrastructure capable of handling the significant growth and economic development needs in our region.

Improvements include road resurfacing, safety improvements, a new traffic signal and pedestrian crosswalks at the Tubbs Mtn. Road intersection, separated multi-modal transportation lanes, ADA sidewalks, street light timing revisions, pedestrian crosswalks, a reduction of continuous curb cuts, and significant stormwater infrastructure improvements, including all new piping and catch basins to address water standing on the roads.
