Install approximately 3,600 linear feet of five feet wide concrete sidewalk and approximately 60 linear feet of a five feet wide aluminum pedestrian bridge on the east side of Highway 165. This will connect a current sidewalk at the Charleston County St. Paul's Service Center at 5962 Highway 165 with a shopping area, several neighborhoods, and a historic depot and playground at Martin Street to the South.	\$1,405,912.50	Overall cost items include the following: Mobilization, Bonds, Insurance, ETC. Construction Staking, and As-Builts. Erosion and Sediment Control, Clearing Grading, and Grubbing. 4" thick x 5' width concrete sidewalk, broom finish, aluminum 5' width Pedestrian Bridge with Handrails. Drainage Repair and Modifications. General Contingency 25%, and Non-Construction costs of design, surveying, permitting, and easement acquisition. Total costs estimated \$1,405,912.50.

Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

Many residents travel to Highway 165 to reach the shopping area. Many residents living along Hwy 165 travel by foot or bicycle. This presents a challenging and dangerous situation conflicting with vehicular traffic along this highway. The oldest portions of Ravenel are located along Martin & Drayton Street and the residents of these established subdivisions use Highway 165 to travel to the newer commercial areas along Savannah Highway. The construction of the sidewalk would alleviate many of the dangers presented by pedestrians traveling along the edge of Highway 165. This project will serve the general public by increasing the safety and welfare of the residents in the area and existing surrounding subdivisions that travel by foot or bicycle along Hwy 165 and Martin and Drayton streets.
